Responsible to Orienteering NZ Council through General Manager

Tenure 3 years for Panel. Appointed by Orienteering NZ Council.

Purpose To ensure Orienteering NZ has a fair and transparent process for selection of

international and representative teams.

Personal qualities The position requires an experienced orienteer with extensive all round knowledge of NZ

orienteering.

A Selector should have:

• an awareness of the nature of elite and international competition

• a knowledge and interest in the capabilities and personalities of top New Zealand orienteers (junior, elite and veteran)

well-connected throughout the orienteering community in New Zealand

• the ability to commit time to the selection panel which may include attendances as trial and selection events.

Remuneration This position is volunteer in its nature.

Direct expenses will be paid on provision of receipts and only within the budget

allowance agreed with the General Manager.

Principal Tasks & Performance Expectations

The Selection Panels' duties are to ensure a fair and transparent process for team selections is followed. Their duties are to:

- Select teams for Orienteering NZ in accordance with Team Selection Criteria
- Recommend team selections in compliance with competition rules and international regulations
- Provide the Orienteering NZ Executive Committee with team selections, and appropriate rationale, for endorsement in a timely manner
- Provide advice and direction on team selection criteria as required
- Provide information and advice if required as part of a Team Selection Appeals
