

## JUNIOR WORLD ORIENTEERING CHAMPIONSHIPS (JWOC) COACH

### Position Description

<b>Responsible to</b>	Orienteering NZ Council through General Manager
<b>Tenure</b>	<p>The appointment is for 1 year. The Manager is expected to travel to the Junior World Orienteering Championships with the team. The Junior World Orienteering Championships will be held in Baia Mare, Romainia, 2-9 July 2023</p> <p>(Travel to/from championships and pre-event training have not been included in these dates).</p>
<b>Purpose</b>	The JWOC Coach is to lead athlete training and preparation as well as coach the NZ representative team at JWOC to perform to the best of their ability.
<b>Personal qualities</b>	<p>The Coach is expected to work with all athletes who have been selected for the 2022 Junior World Championships team.</p> <p>The Coach must be NZ-based and be available to attend NZ competitions, including the JWCO Trials, if required.</p> <p>The position requires an internationally experienced orienteer with sufficient time to devote to the role, with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Excellent communication and motivational skills</li><li>• Sound interpersonal skills</li><li>• The ability to organise and plan</li><li>• Coaching experience with a thorough understanding of the techniques involved in competitive orienteering</li></ul>
<b>Remuneration</b>	The position is voluntary in its nature with a modest budget for NZ-based training costs. Coach travel, accommodation, and food costs while overseas with the team will be paid for by ONZ.

### Principal Tasks & Performance Expectations

1. Assist individual members of the team to achieve their full potential by support, guidance and motivation
  - advise team members on such matters as training programmes, health, injuries etc.
  - analyse individual performance (competitive) and technical skills (training)
  - use motivational techniques appropriate to each individual
  - encourage group and individual discussion of performance
2. To work closely with the ONZ Performance Leader for monitoring, athlete physical and technical preparation.
